1. Executive Summary

The FutureID project builds a comprehensive, flexible, privacy-aware and ubiquitously usable identity management infrastructure for Europe. Having an identity management that integrates existing eID technology and trust infrastructures will lead to the emerging of federated identity management services and modern credential technologies. This will further provides a user-centric system for the trustworthy and accountable management of identity claims.

The FutureID infrastructure will provide great benefits to all stakeholders involved in the eID value chain. Users will benefit from the availability of a ubiquitously usable open source eID client that is capable of running on arbitrary desktop PCs, tablets and modern Smartphones.
